The school makes sure my child is well prepared for the future (transition to next class/keystage/school) The response from parents/carers was 70% always and 30% mostly. To improve this, the staff and I would like to build in meet and greet sessions across the school for September to give you opportunity to meet the next class teacher and find out about the year ahead. I know the infant classes do this, but we would like to start offering this across junior classes as well.
