Spelling

As mentioned previously, we will be sending home more individualised spellings for your children. These spellings will be worked on at school as well as sent home and are available for you if you would like to support at home. Class I & 2 will be coming home with spellings today. Classes 3-6 have been assessed in class and will start on a target level programme, a system I have used before with great results. The list that is sent home on Monday focusses on a rule which will be specific to that target. Each rule has a list of words for your child to work through. They can do this in small blocks if it helps. There will not be a weekly test of words learnt by memory, but the children need to learn the rule and the words within this.

Children can look, cover, check the words (there is a sheet on our website for this), and challenge themselves to write the words in sentences. If you feel your child is ready for a test and knows their rule, make a note in their reading diary and they will be booked in for a test. Children will be tested every few weeks anyway as they will be learning from the same rule in class, but as some rules are quite lengthy they might take longer than a week. Once









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they have passed their target, they will progress to the next level and this will come home. There are 23 levels in total which stretch well beyond year 6. have ordered some special shiny spelling stickers as rewards.
