

Dear Children, parents and carers,

We hope that you have all had a lovely half term break. This term our topic is 'All the World's a Stage' which will see the children rehearsing, practising and perfecting our performance of Roald Dahl's Snow White and the Seven Dwarves. Our performances will take place on Monday 3rd April and Tuesday 4th April at 6.00pm – details regarding tickets will follow later in the term.

Our specialist French and Music lessons will continue this term. French will take place on Tuesday afternoon and Music on Wednesday afternoon.

Home Learning

We will be sending home the lines and songs that your child needs to learn and remember for our play rehearsals. Please could you help them to learn these so that they feel more confident when they perform. We hope that we can rehearse without scripts by Friday 24th March.

Your child has received a new Home Learning brochure with tasks linked to our topic for the next 5 weeks.

Children will continue to be tested on their spellings every Friday and the words they are expected to learn for their year group. Spellings will be given out every week for your children to practise at home.

In addition to weekly home learning, we expect all children to:

- Read daily (with an adult or independently)
 - Practise times tables, with division facts in a mixed order, up to 12 x 12 (www.multiplication.com and 'hit the button' are great websites for this)
- Request: Please can Maths homework be completed in pencil and not pen. It looks so much neater!

Mathletics

So far, we have unlocked the following topics for your children to practise:

- Number & place value
- Addition & subtraction
- Multiplication & division
- Fractions
- Time

We often set tasks to recap the learning in school and expect children to complete these tasks. There is a question mark icon within each task to help children if they need support. We hope to see more children receiving Mathletics merits in our Time to Shine assemblies.
