Dear Children, parents and carers,

Welcome back! This term our topic will be Mouse Bird Snake Wolf, based on the book by David Almond. We will spend the first two weeks studying different forms of poetry before beginning to read the graphic novel. To link with the topic, we will be learning about food chains, teeth and the digestive system in Science. As we approach December, we will have an exciting enterprise topic, which you will find out about nearer the time. We are very fortunate in Class 4 to have Mrs Hancock with us until December on her university teaching placement. She will be working alongside Mrs Voss and teaching across all areas of the curriculum.

## Home Learning

Your child has received a new Home Learning brochure with tasks linked to our topic for the next 6 weeks. The brochure outlines the English or creative tasks they should complete each week, graded with the star challenge to help children choose which tasks they would like to complete.

Maths tasks will continue to be set weekly and should be completed in a Maths exercise book (unless Mathletics tasks have been set). Children will continue to be tested on their spellings every Friday and the words they are expected to learn for their year group. Spellings will be given out every week for your children to practise at home.

In addition to weekly home learning, we expect all children to:

• Read daily (with an adult or independently)

• Practise times tables, with division facts in a mixed order, up to 12 x 12 (www.multiplication.com is a great website for this) Request: Please can Maths homework be completed in pencil and not pen. All homework needs to be handed in no later than Tuesday to allow us time to mark the work before handing out new tasks on Wednesday. Thank you!

## Home Reading

It has been lovely to hear the children talking about the books they have been en joying at home, although very few of them are recording this in their Reading Diaries. Please help your child to make a record of the books they are reading and feel free to add entries yourself. Reading records need to come into school daily and should go home at the end of the day. Evidence of regular reading at home in the reading record will also help your child earn a tick for their AK Star Badge!

## General Reminders...
