





IN 1845 THOMAS JOHN BARNARDO WAS BORN.













IN LONDON HE STARTED TO REALLY NOTICE ALL THE POOR PEOPLE.





Some children had to live on the streets.




One night a boy called Jim Jarvis showed Dr Barnardo some children who did not have anywhere to sleep.

CHILDREN.


