As part of our school improvement plan, to develop the entrepreneurial skills of our children through our *Shine Enterprise* project, our children have been busy designing and making goods to sell. Classes have been set the challenge to raise £3 per child for their ticket to the theatre in the school production of *Charlotte's Web* I have booked for the Summer. Last year I treated the whole school to a production of *The Lion Witch and Wardrobe* and this year I thought it would be excellent for children to earn their ticket to the show through enterprise. Any additional money raised by each class is theirs to spend in whichever way they wish. Last year, Year 4 bought binoculars and nature books and went on a nature walk to the Millenium green as this is what they wanted to spend their enterprise money on. Class 5 this year have just finished their hot chocolate business and made a profit of a staggering £140! They have paid for their tickets to the theatre show and are now thinking about what the class would like to buy together.

I know all 7 classes have been working very hard for the Christmas market next Friday and have some beautiful items to sell. There are many items created through their forest school sessions too which is excellent. So please bring your pennies and come and buy, I know the children will be delighted to see you! The enterprise initiative will continue all year so look out for notices in my newsletters and on the playground/ parent mail as they pop up.


