

This booklet contains suggested homework for the next 5 weeks.

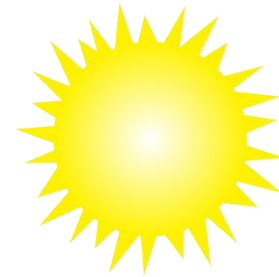
It contains a variety of fun activities for you to do with your child at home.
