Dear and family,

A very warm welcome to Ashton Keynes Primary School. We hope your child is settling into school well, please feel free to come in with any questions or queries.

For the first couple of weeks along with the rest of the school, lots of our learning will be based on the book 'The River Story'. Amongst other things we will be exploring water, the children will be making their own boats and testing them out to see if they hopefully float!

'Marvellous Me!' will be our next theme and through this we will be continuing to get to know each other, comparing similarities and differences between ourselves and thinking about our families, our homes, our likes and dislikes. We will be asking you to provide a baby photo so that we can discover how we have changed.

As the weather turns chillier we will be using our senses to find out about **Autumn** and the changes in our environment. We will go on an Autumn walk and there will be conkers galore!

As soon as the children start full time we will begin our teaching of phonics. We will be holding a phonics information afternoon for parents on Wednesday 26th September in the school hall at 2.45pm.
