


Year 4

In every piece of writing, I should be:

- ✓ Adapting my work depending on the audience;
- ✓ Proof-reading my writing for spelling and use of punctuation;
- ✓ Using the correct verb form e.g. we were instead of we was;
- ✓ Using an adverbial phrase at the start of some sentences e.g. Later that day, I completed my homework;
- ✓ Using paragraphs to organise my writing so that blocks of text flow and ideas are grouped together;
 - ✓ Drafting and rewriting work that creates settings, characters and plots that excite the reader by using my best vocabulary;
- ✓ Using a mixture of pronouns and nouns (he, she, they, I, it) to aid continuity and avoid words being repeated;
 - ✓ Using inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech e.g.: The teacher announced, "You are amazing!"

Focusing on these objectives will help you reach further and shine even brighter! 😊

Always give yourself enough time to produce a high quality piece of work and **check it through carefully** so that spellings you know are correct and use a dictionary to make corrections - just like in class.

Throughout this topic, there are frequent extension activities to offer challenge. Usually the level of challenge builds, so 2* tasks must include the 1* features as well as 2*.

Writing tasks and practical tasks are included to make the tasks fun and appealing to all. I hope you really enjoy these activities!

For Tuesday 20th November

- 3* Include at least 5 facts about Romans in your poster - make them fascinating so people are desperate to visit your museum. Include text boxes, subheadings and ensure your poster's layout is clear and eye-catching **WOW** Use alliteration in your title

For Tuesday 27th November

We saw some spectacular mosaics at the Corinium Museum. For your homework this week create a mosaic that could have been found in a Roman villa. You can do this in a variety of ways. By using collage materials, actual tiles, hand drawing the mosaic or using this fantastic website:

For Tuesday 4th December

Draw/paint a picture of something from Romans times e.g. a Roman banquet, or chariot racing. Write a descriptive caption to go with it.

- 1* Make use of adjectives to describe
- 2* Use adjectives, well-chosen verbs and adverbs to write a descriptive paragraph for your picture
- 3* Try using figurative language like similes or perhaps even personification or a metaphor in your paragraph

For Tuesday 11th December

Write a short newspaper report announcing the invasion of Britain (Decide whether you're a Roman or British newspaper first.)

- 1* Include a catchy headline
- 2* Include text boxes, pictures and at least 5 facts about the invasion
- 3* Include quotes from soldiers and local people involved in the invasion, such as a farmer who had their house captured and used to house soldiers.

For Tuesday 18th December

Write a diary entry from someone working in a Roman Villa in Britain. Make sure you have a suitable opening to hook the reader and use words to add interest.

- 1* Use some adjectives to describe and well-chosen verbs.
- 2* Make use of interesting openers and include suitable punctuation.
- 3* Consider your presentation. Remember to use paragraphs. Make the reader feel happy or sorry for the person writing the diary. Are they enjoying their job or is it difficult?
