Week 1 (w/c 27th Jan)

Week 3 (w/c 10th Feb)

Have a go at this dice game. Feel free to use more dice/adapt the game if you want to. This game will help your child practise simple addition and number writing.

Player 1 rolls 2 dice, counts the total number of spots and writes the number. Player 2 does the same. The player with the greatest number scores a point. First to 10 points wins.
