#### Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to welcome you back after the half term break. We hope you all had a lovely time. We are pleased to be welcoming back Ms Smith into Class 1. She will be working in class on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and Mrs Wilkinson will work on Thursday and Friday. Miss Ballinger will also be continuing her teacher training in class 1 with support and guidance from Ms Smith and Mrs Wilkinson.

This term we will be focusing on local geography and we will be going on a village walk. We will then begin comparing and contrasting our local village with a village in Africa. This is because we will be looking at the book 'Lila and the Secret of Rain'

The build continues and so please can we remind you that children need to have a pair of wellies or old trainers in school if they wish to play on the field or Smooga. This is because with the weather it is just so wet and muddy everywhere! We thank you for your support with this.

Book changes in class one will be on Monday, Wednesday and Friday of each week, starting from next week.

Class 2 will not have set days for book change, but will expect to see daily reading happening. Reading diaries and books should be in school every day so we can record guided reading and any individual reading. Books can be changed when they have been read and recorded in their diary.

Thank you for your continued support with the arrangements for the start of the day, we will be on the playground from 8.45. This will allow you to speak with us about anything. We will then take the children into the classroom .With this please could you try and avoid coming into the cloakroom or walking your children to the classroom door, especially when it is raining. We understand it can be tricky at times, especially when children are upset but be rest assured we will look after them!
