

How to make Papyrus Paper

You will need:

- A brown paper bag
- A paper towel
- Protective mat
- PVA glue
- Water
- Scissors
- Wax crayons/coloured chalk
- Shallow dish



1. Get a brown paper bag and cut it into strips. Then put them to one side.
2. Mix half PVA glue and half water together in a shallow dish.
3. Lay your paper towel on your protective mat.
4. Dip half of your paper strips in your glue mixture then place the strips on the paper towel with their edges overlapping. Then smooth the strips down.
5. Take the rest of your paper strips and repeat step 4 but this time lay your strips going across.
6. Leave to air dry.
7. Once dry, trim any overhanging paper towel.
8. Use wax crayons /coloured chalk to write on your hieroglyphics.
