Homework

Your child's Home Learning brochure with tasks linked to our topic will be uploaded to Showbie. Your children will have a weekly Maths task and a Topic task to complete. Where possible, Maths tasks will be graded with the star challenge, and children will choose which tasks they would like to complete. There will be a weekly spelling test based on the spelling patterns and the words they expected to learn for their year. Spellings will be added to Showbie weekly for your children to practise at home.

In addition to weekly homework, we expect all children to:

- read daily (with an adult or independently)
- practise times tables, with division facts in a mixed order, up to 12 x 12

<u>Spellings</u>

Spelling tests will be on Fridays. Children will be tested on 10 spellings based on a spelling rule and/or statutory words, which are words they are expected to learn for their year group. Please can your child make sure they have their spelling book in school on Friday so they can complete the test in their book and then stick in new spellings. This way you are able to keep track of how they are performing in spelling tests.

Reading

Your child a reading record to record daily reading. If your child is a free reader they are welcome to read books from our class bookshelf, their own books from home or books from the local or school library. Reading books and records should be in school daily.

General Reminders...

- Year 5's PE sessions will be on Thursday afternoon and Year 6's sessions will be Friday afternoon. It is essential that children come to school in a full, labelled PE kit in school, including a water bottle. If appropriate, your child may have a roll-on antiperspirant deodorant in their PE bag too (no aerosols please). Children are to wear the PE kits to school with dark tracksuit bottoms and their school jumper on the day they have PE.
