Dear Parents and Carers,

Where is the term going? I cannot believe we are already mid-May and into our final Summer term! We have been super busy in school and making sure we make the most of every minute we have together. This is a short update with a couple of highlights as we are all working so hard in school.

## **Classes Shining Brightly:**

The school has been buzzing since our return from Easter and every class is fully embracing the joy of being back in the classroom together. Class R and 1 have had the joy of 'Incredible Eggs' hatching in their classes. The children have thoroughly enjoyed watching carefully and observing the changes in the eggs as they prepared to hatch. The pure excitement of the first crack on the egg was amazing. (Although I think I was just as excited as the children and was feeling like a proud Mumma Duck). Class R have had 3 ducklings in an array of colours and Class 1 have had 7 chicks. I have been inundated with drawings and writing from class R about their ducks which is so lovely. The children have









been carefully nurturing and

looking after the new hatchlings and every morning they run into the classroom to check on them. Emotional coach Lizzie from 'Beanology', a programme which has been designed to help Human 'Beans' rediscover and uncover all that makes them shine, joined us in school to share her passion and to help us think about our well-being. And creating an inner sock coach, and outer sock critic! Lizzie will be joining us 3 times next year with further workshops for all children.

Lunchtimes:

The fine weather we enjoyed last week, really gave us a taste of freedom as we were able to get all of the children out onto the field to run around and get some fresh air.

We do still need to enforce the separate 'bubbles' though, even when outside, so we have devised 7 separate zones of the field, through which each bubble rotates on a weekly basis (one zone per week).
