## **Home-School Agreement**

Our Home School Agreement is a set of expectations that will help your child to achieve their full potential during their time at school. It is a statement of the mutual responsibilities of parents, carers, pupils, teachers and anyone who helps at or visits our school. By attending this school, we agree to work within this agreement together in partnership.

## The School Aims to:

- Provide a balanced curriculum to meet the needs of your child this is our 'Shine Curriculum'.
- Ensure your child is kept safe.
- Care for your child's happiness with consistent expectations, rules and providing exciting rich experiences.
- Encourage all children to do their best at all times.
- Encourage children to become independent learners and develop good learning behaviours.
- Strive to achieve high standards of work and behaviour.
- Encourage children to care for and about each other and their surroundings by developing a sense of responsibility.
- Inform you about what your child's class will be doing each term (class annual overviews, class termly newsletters and class pages of website) and send home a progress report mid-year and a full report in the summer.
- Arrange Parent/carer evenings to discuss your child's progress and share targets for them
- Let you know in a timely manner about any concerns or problems which affect your child's work/wellbeing.
- Be open and welcoming by offering opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school.
- Develop a partnership between school and home.

## Parents/Carers Aim to:

- Encourage and support their child in all school work and homework.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Work alongside the school to maintain high standards and good behaviour.
- Attend parents' evenings to discuss their child's progress.
- Ensure their child attends school on time each school day (8.45am) (8.55am at the latest).
- Notify the school by 9.00 a.m. each day of any absence.
- Make sure their child is properly equipped for each school day.
- Avoid booking holidays or medical/dental appointments during term time.
- Encourage a full attendance of the child at school aiming for 97-100% attendance.

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
