### Phonics and Reading

This term's phonics will be focused upon recapping and consolidating the Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs introduced last term. Please ensure you continue to practise recognising and blending using your phoneme cards at home.

Reading books will continue to be changed twice a week. Please continue to read with your child as often as possible and record in their reading record after each session.

### World Book Day – Thursday 2nd March

This year we have a 'Where's Wally' theme.

All children are welcome to come dressed as a character from the Where's Wally books. This could be as simple as a stripy t-shirt and trousers.



### Forest School

We have noticed that many children are coming to school in clothing that is unsuitable. Children need only wear **old play clothes** for forest school that is suitable for the weather on that day. They will always need a waterproof coat and a pair of wellies!
