- ★ Use the toilet independently and wash their hands.
- ★ Recognise their name and their belongings.
- ★ Use a knife and fork to cut and eat their lunch.
- ★ Put on and take off their coat.

★ To help boost early reading and literacy skills, regularly reading stories to your child is vital and we would encourage you to do this as often as possible.
