

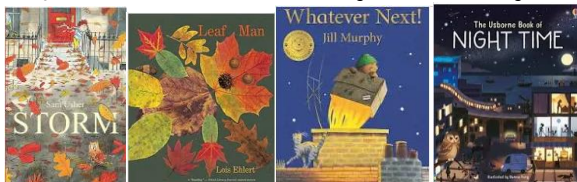


EYFS Newsletter Term 2
