Dear children, parents and carers,

I hope you and your families have all had a brilliant Easter break. The children have worked incredibly hard so far this year and I am really proud of them all. I am looking forward to our final term together and the children's last term at AK. This term our values are 'Service' and 'Truthfulness' and worship time in school will focus on this.

In English, we will be reading the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. Throughout this term, we will be writing a variety of text types to create a bank of writing in our portfolios. We will be continuing to recap grammar, punctuation and spelling too. In Maths, we will be focusing on measurement, ratio, algebra and statistics. In Geography, we will be studying extreme weather and in History this term we will be finding out about the Kingdom of Benin.

#### Home Learning

For this term, in the lead up to SATs, the children will continue to receive two pieces of homework a week. As normal, homework will go out on a **Wednesday** and will be due in on the **following Tuesday**. The first homework of the term will go out on **Wednesday 30**<sup>th</sup> **April**. Please can you ensure that both pieces of homework are completed at home and handed in on time each week; thank you for your support with this. In addition, our expectation is still that children read each day for at least 10-15 minutes. Children can read independently or to an adult daily. We expect every child to record their daily reading, even if it's just a short note, so that we can keep track of their progress. Please support your child by reminding them to complete this task each day - thank you.

## **RSE**
